..... was graded with Wests in 1926 and played until 1929. He played his one and only First Grade game in 1927, but played twenty three Reserve Grade and a further seven Third Grade games during his time at Wests. In September 1927, Frank Bartley was selected in combined Third Grade team with four other Wests Third Grade players for an end of season tour to the NSW Country.

Frank Bartley lived in the Canterbury Bankstown and St George districts all of his life. He died at Peakhurst, NSW in August 1962. His memorial is at the Rookwood Cemetery, Rookwood, NSW, Catholic Section, Lawn 1, Row 8.
